## Food Share & Farmers' Market Program

If a person has food share, he or she is eligible to use food share dollars at participating farmers' markets.

In addition, persons on food share can match their dollars spent on fresh fruits and vegetables at the markets.

## Senior Vouchers & Farmers' Market Program

If a person is over the age of 60 (tribal members over the age of 55) and low income, they may be eligible for vouchers at participating farmers' markets and farm stands.

Limited number of vouchers are available in the spring before market season. An application is required. Homebound persons may use a proxy for the application and purchasing of food at the participating markets and farm stands. For more information, contact the ADRC (920-448-4300).

## Community Gardens (UW-Extension)

Community gardens are available throughout the Green Bay area. A small fee is charged for the rental of a garden plot. For information contact the Brown County UW-Extension (920-391-4610).
