**Update as of 9/29/22:** If a customer is required to have a rep payee with social security and lose their payee: Social Security MAY allow them to manage their own finances short-term if they can get a doctor's note stating they they are able AND a letter of support from the person that will be helping them (supports, friend/family). Social Security understands there is a shortage of rep payee services at this time. Customers can speak directly to social security for specifics or be referred to a benefit specialist.
