

# Disability Work Incentives



Did you know that you can still earn money while receiving Social Security Disability benefits (SSDI) or Supplemental Security Income (SSI)?

## What does a Work Incentive Benefit Specialist (WIBS) or Work Incentive Planning & Assistance (WIPA) do?

If you are thinking about getting a job, have a job offer, or want to learn how work earnings will affect your disability payments, call a WIBS or WIPA.

- WIBS can provide information to help a person understand how earnings may affect disability payments and other benefits such as Medicaid, Medicare, FoodShare, or housing.
- WIPA can provide information to help a person understand how work earnings affect disability payments and associated Medicare and Medicaid.
