

ADRC Nutrition Program Information

Gathering Grounds:

Join us for a healthy meal offered throughout Brown County at Grounded Café, community dining locations, ADRC on the Go and Grounded Food Truck events. Complete your annual registration, receive a scan card and enjoy up to one meal each weekday on a voluntary contribution basis for those age 60 and older.

Who is Eligible for a Meal?

You are eligible if you are 60 years and older or if you are the spouse of an eligible individual and annual registration is complete. Everyone else is welcome to dine at the full menu cost. Home Delivered Meals have additional eligibility requirements. Please call 920-448-4300 for more information or to apply.

What is the cost?

The full cost of the meal is \$13.39. Eligible individuals can dine for a voluntary contribution of \$5.00. Eligible individuals will not be denied based on their ability to donate. All contributions support the nutrition program so please donate what your budget allows. Everyone is welcome to dine at the full meal cost.

Notice: Due to funding limits, the Home Delivered Meal Program currently has a waitlist. Wait times and placement into the program may vary based on availability.
